CONVENING

The City Council met in a special session at 4:00 p.m. in Council Chambers of the City/County Government Office Building. Council President Smith called the meeting to order.

ORDINANCE NO. 2110 – 2ND READING – APPROVING AN AMENDMENT OF THE FY10 GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO ADDRESS A DEFICIT IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FUND (\$105,683) – presented by City Attorney Paul Wilber

Ordinance No. 2110 for second reading was unanimously approved on a motion by Mrs. Campbell and seconded by Mrs. Shields.

ORDINANCE NO. 2111 – 2ND READING – AMENDING THE FY10 BUDGET TO ADDRESS DEFICITS IN THE CITY ATTORNEY AND PUBLIC WORKS BUDGETS – presented by City Attorney Paul Wilber


Mrs. Campbell moved and Ms. Cohen seconded to approve Ordinance No. 2111 for second reading to amend the FY10 General Fund Budget as follows:

- 1) Decrease Debt-Service & Other Uses by \$20,000*
- 2) Increase City Attorney by \$20,000*
- 3) Decrease Sanitation by \$40,726*
- 4) Increase Public Works – Traffic Control by \$1,800*
- 5) Increase Public Works – Streets & Lighting by \$5,111*
- 6) Increase Public Works – Fleet Management by \$8,180*
- 7) Increase Public Works – Recreation & culture by \$25,635*

Mrs. Campbell moved and Ms. Cohen seconded to amend Ordinance No. 2111 by increasing the funding for the City Attorney from \$20,000 to \$30,000. The Council recessed at 4:20 p.m. and reconvened at 4:25 p.m. Following further discussion, the amendment passed unanimously. Ordinance No. 2111, as amended for second reading, passed unanimously.

The special meeting adjourned at 4:35 p.m.






